Instructions for EGD

- Stop any full strength **aspirin, ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin), Iron Pills** or **anti-inflammatory medications (Aleve, Mobic, diclofenac, Celebrex, naproxen etc)** 5 days before the procedure. If you take any **blood thinners**, (Plavix, Coumadin, Eliquis, Aggrenox, etc.) we ask that you stop these 5 days prior to the procedure. **Tylenol is ok.** Please contact the prescribing physician for clearance of stopping these medications.
- Do not take any Diabetic medication OR insulin the **DAY OF** procedure.
- All other medications may be taken the morning of the procedure as long as they are not any of the above listed medicines.
- Do not eat anything after 8 PM or drink anything after midnight the night before your procedure IF you are scheduled in the morning. If your procedure is in the afternoon, clear liquids only from 12 AM -6 AM and then nothing by mouth after 6 AM the morning of the procedure.
- You will **need a driver** the day of the procedure. The driver must remain at the facility **the entire** duration of the procedure.
- If you can't keep this appointment, We have a **72 business hour cancellation/ reschedule policy**; failure to do so will result in **\$150.00** fee, not payable by insurance.
